



## PROCLAMATION

### Amended Declaration of Local Emergency

**Whereas**, the Coronavirus (COVID-19) continues to spread throughout the State of Arizona, putting communities like Winslow at risk; and

**Whereas**, on March 11, 2020, the Governor of the State of Arizona, Douglas A. Ducey, declared a state of emergency for the State of Arizona; and

**Whereas**, on March 13, 2020, the President of the United States, Donald J. Trump, declared a national state of emergency for the United States; and

**Whereas**, on March 16, 2020, the President of the United States issued "Coronavirus Guidelines for America," emphasizing the serious threat to public health, safety and welfare represented by COVID-19; and

**Whereas**, on March 17, 2020, the City Council of the City of Winslow adopted Resolution No. 1836 authorizing the Mayor, by Proclamation, to issue a "Declaration of Local Emergency", effective March 21, 2020; and

**Whereas**, on March 17, 2020, the Mayor issued a Proclamation "Declaring Local Emergency", effective March 21, 2020 and until April 3, 2020, and ordered the closure of certain City facilities and non-essential services; and

**Whereas**, on March 21, 2020, the Mayor of the City of Winslow issued the an Emergency Declaration requiring the closure to the public of City of Winslow facilities, parks recreational events, meetings and non-essential services, contractual projects and consulting services, and all non-essential businesses, services, and other non-essential establishments within the jurisdictional boundary of the City of Winslow; and

**Whereas**, on March 23, 2020, the Governor of Arizona issued Executive Order 2020-12, entitled "Prohibiting the Closure of Essential Services" declaring certain businesses as essential, requiring governmental bodies to ensure a plan for essential governmental functions, and preempting local governments from making or issuing any order, rule, or regulation that prohibits any person from performing any functions designated by the Governor, Director of Arizona Department of Health Services, or Division of Emergency Management as an essential function; and

**Whereas**, on March 30, 2020, the Governor of Arizona issued Executive Order 2020-18, entitled "Stay Home, Stay Healthy, Stay Connected," Physical Distancing to Mitigate COVID-19 Transmission, further establishing social distancing requirements, essential services, functions, and businesses, and pre-empting local authority: and

**Whereas**, the Mayor has determined a local emergency continues to exist because of the threats to public health and safety created by the calamity that COVID-19 represents and desires to cooperate with State, County, and local authorities to combat the spread of COVID-19 and communicate the importance of social distancing to City residents and businesses;

**Now, Therefore**, I, Thomas L. McCauley, Mayor of the City of Winslow, do hereby proclaim a local disaster to exist in Winslow, Arizona, indefinitely and until further notice, and urge all of our citizens to take the necessary precautions and to follow the guidance and directives of government officials to help mitigate the effects of COVID-19 on the City of Winslow.

**Further**, pursuant to A.R.S. § 26-317, a person who violates any of the prohibitions issued during this state of emergency shall be guilty of a class 1 misdemeanor. Any violation which is continuing in nature shall constitute a separate offense on each successive date the violation continues, unless otherwise provided.

**Further**, I direct the City Manager, or designee, to coordinate emergency operations for Winslow, implement the continuity of government plan required by the State, and to take all appropriate actions needed to mitigate the effects COVID-19 on Winslow.


**Further**, I declare that all existing laws, ordinances, orders, rules, and regulations in conflict with this proclamation shall be suspended during the time of this proclamation to the extent they conflict.

**Further**, I urge all citizens and businesses in the City of Winslow, including owners of businesses determined to be Essential Services under Executive Order 2020-12, to establish social distancing practices for their patrons, limit face-to-face interactions and social gatherings, and explore and implement measures to protect public health and safety.

**Finally**, I declare that in the event Governor Ducey amends, revises or otherwise imposes different restrictions than are set forth in his current Executive Orders, such amendments, revisions and different restrictions shall apply and be incorporated herein.

This proclamation shall be effective immediately and shall remain in effect until a withdrawal of the Proclamation of Emergency, filed with the Clerk. Additional regulations may be forthcoming as needed.
