*EXECUTIVE ORDER AND EMERGENCY DECLARATION
POLICY UPDATES AND CLARIFICATIONS*

*For further clarification regarding the Executive Order of the Mayor of Winslow, Arizona, through Resolution Number 1836 and by Proclamation "Declaring a Local Emergency", each passed the 17th Day of March, 2020, effective March 21, 2020 and until April 3, 2020, **the City strongly encourages the following actions by all City businesses from April 1st through April 15th:***

With the high volume of regional visitor and customer traffic anticipated in our City from April 1st through April 15th, it is imperative that all of our business establishments observe CDC and ADHS guidance by taking extra measures to prohibit personal contact, observe and closely monitor employee and customer behavior, practice social distancing (separation of 6 feet or more), require frequent hand washing (20 seconds or more at a time), and maintain clean and sanitary conditions within both customer-service and employee-only areas of all business establishments in the City.

With this in mind, the City advises the following:

- *Businesses categorized as “non-essential” are encouraged to close their doors to the public or strongly restrict access and personal contact within your facility from April 1st through April 15th, 2020.*
- *Businesses categorized as “essential” under the Governor’s Emergency Declaration (2020-12), dated March 23, 2020 are encouraged to strongly restrict access and personal contact within your facility from April 1st through April 15th, 2020.*

While I and my fellow City officials continue to closely track the spread of the coronavirus and its potential impacts on our City, we appreciate the respective operational decisions made by our local businesses in response to the recent state and local emergency declarations. In the interest of our public health and safety, it is incumbent upon every member of our business community to work together and adhere to these guidelines as we continue to navigate through this time of uncertainty.
