### COVID-19 POLICY UPDATES AND CLARIFICATIONS

#### WASTE MANAGEMENT TRASH COLLECTION OPPORTUNITY TO INCREASE TRASH SERVICE/PICK-UP

With the recent issuance of the Governor's Order 2020-18, "Stay Home, Stay Healthy, State Connected" on March 30, 2020," many families are spending more time at home in support of our community's effort to flatten the curve of the spread of COVID-19. We understand that this may be creating a situation where customers may have household trash piling up more than usual.

In an effort to better address these temporary circumstances, City trash service will continue as usual and will offer additional service opportunities:

- The City will continue to provide the current weekly pick-up schedule for trash and recyclables with no changes.

- Customers experiencing a higher volume of household trash may request an additional day of trash service per week for the time being. This service would be provided using your current 96-gallon trash cart.
- Monday customers would receive an extra pickup of trash on Thursdays. Tuesday customers would receive an extra pickup of trash on Fridays.
- This policy does not affect your current recycling service in any way. Recycling will continue on the current schedule.
- The cost for a second weekly trash pickup using your current 96-gallon cart will be \$8.00 per month, and would be added to your monthly account for trash service by the Finance Department.
- Customers would have the opportunity to order this service on a temporary or permanent basis.
- Customers may contact the City Finance Department at (928) 289-5533 to order an additional pick up per week.

Additional trash service is offered on a voluntary basis. No customer will be required to purchase this additional service and will not be solicited to do so. This is simply an additional option for trash disposal that may be of help to customers. We understand that not all customers will require this additional service, either now or in the future. Those households with more trash volume than usual may take advantage of this opportunity, however it is not intended by any means to be a “one size fits all” solution.

We strongly encourage everyone to stay home as much as possible and practice mandatory social-distancing during this time of uncertainty, and to please do your best to abide by all of the emergency restrictions that have been issued by our Federal, State and local leadership.
