



The Mayor, Council and staff of the City of Winslow are pleased to sponsor the "Shopping for the Elderly" program in partnership with local civic groups and individual volunteers. This program will assist our elderly citizens with their shopping needs during this uncertain time.

This service will begin Friday, March 20, 2020, and will be available Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

Elderly citizens in need of assistance may call City Hall at (928) 289-1476. The City will have a volunteer visit your home, pick up your shopping list and payment, and then proceed with shopping and return your items.

Any individuals or community groups who would like to generously volunteer to shop for elderly citizens may call City Hall at (928) 289-1476 to register. This is a volunteer program and no compensation will be made to the volunteers. City employees may also be dispatched for this purpose if there is not a volunteer available. We kindly ask that any individual or member of a community group who has experienced an illness within the last 30 days not volunteer for this program. This will allow the City to protect the health and safety of our elderly citizens.
