POLICY UPDATES AND CLARIFICATIONS

EMERGENCY DECLARATIONS TIMELINE

April 2, 2020

As of April 2, 2020, here is a timeline of official actions taken to date by the Winslow City Council and the Governor of Arizona:

- ***April 1, 2020***
 - *The City Council unanimously approved an amendment to the Executive Order of the Mayor of Winslow, Arizona, passed by Resolution Number 1836 and by Proclamation “Declaring of Local Emergency”, the 17th Day of March, 2020, effective March 21, 2020 and until April 3, 2020, extending the Mayor’s Executive Order in compliance with the Governor’s Executive Order of March 30, 2020, and effective March 31, 2020, for an indefinite time period.*
 - *As of March 31, 2020, the City Council hereby follows the Governor’s Executive Order 2020-18, entitled “Stay Home,*

Stay Healthy, Stay Connected,” Physical Distancing to Mitigate COVID-19 Transmission, issued on March 30, 2020 and which pre-empts City authority to take further action.

- **March 30, 2020**

- *The Director of the Arizona Department of Health Services, based on an epidemiological assessment of Arizona specific data and in alignment with CDC guidance, recommends the state implement enhanced mitigation strategies. Governor issues Executive Order 2020-18, effective at 5:00 p.m. on March 31, 2020.*

- **March 26, 2020**

- *The City issues a policy update strongly encouraging City businesses categorized as “non-essential” to close their doors to the public or strongly restrict access and personal contact, and businesses categorized as “essential” under the Governor’s Emergency Declaration (2020-12), dated March 23, 2020, to strongly restrict access and personal contact from April 1st through April 15th, 2020.*
- *The City Finance Department issues guidance on payments for all City services including water bills, with a delay of enforcement on delinquent payments for all Winslow citizens.*

- **March 21, 2020**

- *As a precautionary measure to help reduce the spread of the Coronavirus, by Executive Order of the Mayor of Winslow, Arizona, through Resolution Number 1836 and by Proclamation “Declaring of Local Emergency”, each passed the 17th Day of March, 2020, effective to March 21, 2020 and until April 3, 2020, the Mayor of the City of Winslow issues an Emergency Declaration.*

- *The City announces closure of City facilities, including City Hall, Public Library (book drop and WIFI available), water and wastewater treatment facilities, WPD and WFD stations (restricted access), indoor recreation facilities, playgrounds and restrooms (parks are still open), events and leagues, contractual projects and consulting services, and all non-essential businesses, services, and other non-essential establishments within the jurisdictional boundary of the City of Winslow as of 5:00 PM, Saturday March 21, 2020.*

- **March 19, 2020**
 - *The Governor’s Executive Order 2020-09 is issued, requiring all restaurants in Arizona counties with confirmed COVID-19 cases to provide dine-out options only and requiring all bars, gyms and movie theaters in those counties to close.*

 - *The Governor’s Executive Order 2020-10 halts all elective surgeries in the State of Arizona to free up medical resources and maintain the capacity for hospitals and providers to continue offering vital services.*
